## CIF Eludes '67 Seniors as Tribe Takes Second

The Class of '67 saw a winning trend begin in football. In the last two years the Indians placed second then third in the Foothill League, and for fall the slogan is "Burroughs First."

Both years teams consisted of players able to function with split-second timing which enabled them to come through in tight situations and score when they needed the points. A number of outstanding players supplied leadership and ability invaluable to the team.

At the top of the list of Burroughs senior stars is Dick Sheppard, City Player of the Year, All League First Team, and All San Fernando Valley First Team. Tom Babagian, the only three year letterman, was co-captain of the team with Jerry Lee, who made the all CIF third team. Al Pardo and Don Davio also were on all Foothill league teams.

Other senior lettermen were Bill Weber, Chuck Morrow, Gene Hebert, Vic Georgino, Larry Linder, Bob Stumph, Bob Lauerman, Ray Shultz, and Jim Gillis.

Senior captain of the 'B' team was Larry Phoenix, who played halfback and defensive back. Other senior starters were Dave White, Mike Bunch, and Mark Pucci. Tom Howell and Dennis Smith also lettered.

# Garza All-League for Second Year

The Indians finished the 1967 Foothill league with a 5-9 record and two seniors

named to the first and second all-league teams.

John Garza, who made the Foothill first team for the second year in a row, showed his talent when he was in center field and at bat. He was co-captain of the team.

## Track Seniors Led by Morris

The 1967 track team finished the season in the second division but witnessed many outstanding individual efforts. Although the varsity ended up 1 and 8, the accomplishments on the season can only be appreciated disregarding the record. The squad has been going through a coaching change the last three years, and it seems that the new track procedures have finally settled down.

This year's team was led by senior Steve Morris. Morris topped the 14'8" mark to place him in contention for the CIF finals. Steve finished sixth among the other contestants to climax an exciting year. He also was selected the top varsity man at the Sports Banquet. In the other field events, Larry Phoenix paced the team in the long jump flying 20'11". Paul Broneer stayed on top of the shot putters by breaking the 51' mark.

### Sprinters Exciting

Indian sprinters held an exceptional year with many close races. In the sprints senior Mike Bunch was top 100-yard sprinter with a time of 10.2 and followed up with a 220 time of 23.2. Jim Gillis managed to churn out a 53.5 in the 440. In the hurdles, Dave White ran a neat 14.0 in the 120 low hurdles while going 9.6 in the 70-yard highs. He was also high point man on the 'B' team. Ray Shultz led the varsity hurdlers with a 15.0 in the 120-yard highs and a 20.5 in the 180-yard lows. Larry Phoenix also backed up the hurdlers running a 14.0 120 low hurdles and a 9.9 in the 70-yard highs.

The distance men had trouble bringing in points, but Phil Patton took honors in the 880 by running a 2:03.6.

Bruce Cook, named the most valuable player, made the Foothill second team and was noted for his quick reflexes in tight situations.

Randy Bowman was the other varsity captain. He started the season playing shortstop but was moved to the pitcher's position.

Chuck Morrow was a fantastic first baseman, leading the team in home runs, doubles, and triples.

Other seniors on the squad were Marshall Gilbert and Bob Lauerman.

## Lack of Depth Hurts Swimmers

A lack of depth caused another heartbreaking season for the swim team. The team was composed of only a few outstanding swimmers without the heavy reinforcement necessary to win meets.

The fastest times were usually made by the Burroughs' side, but the meets were lost because of our inability to take the seconds and thirds. The season ended with a 2 win, 9 loss record, and was the third year in a row that Burroughs has gone without a single league victory.

Mark Sternfels, who lettered in his sophomore and junior years, and Phil Kasper, who lettered in his junior year, were not able to return to the team. This accounted for a loss of points that Coach Edwards had counted on.

The only senior letterman was Steve Stiefvater, a diver who swam the butterfly. Allen Bell and Mike Pohjola, seniors, both received 'B' letters in their junior years.

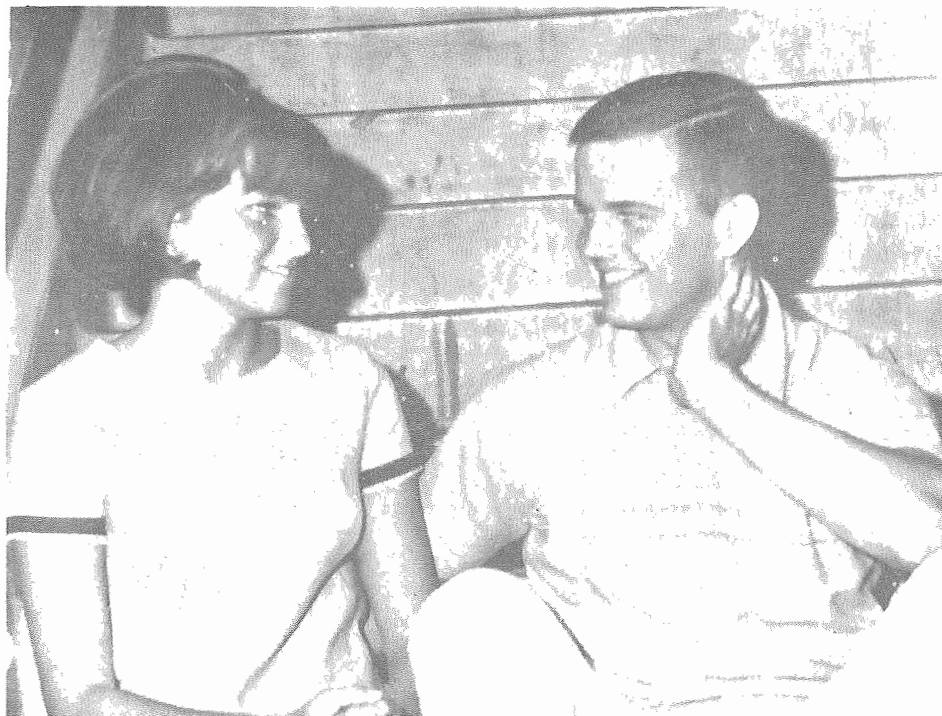

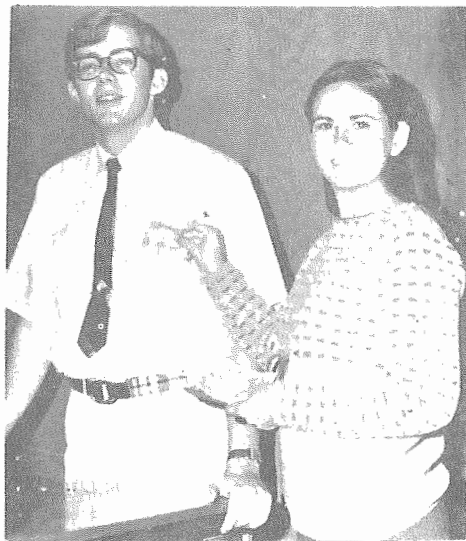
